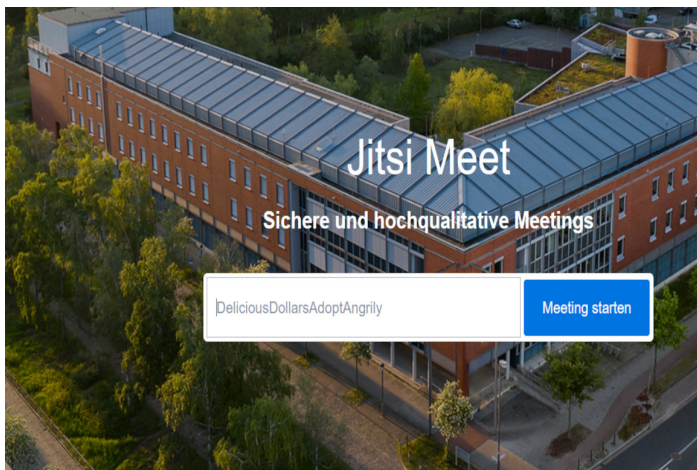




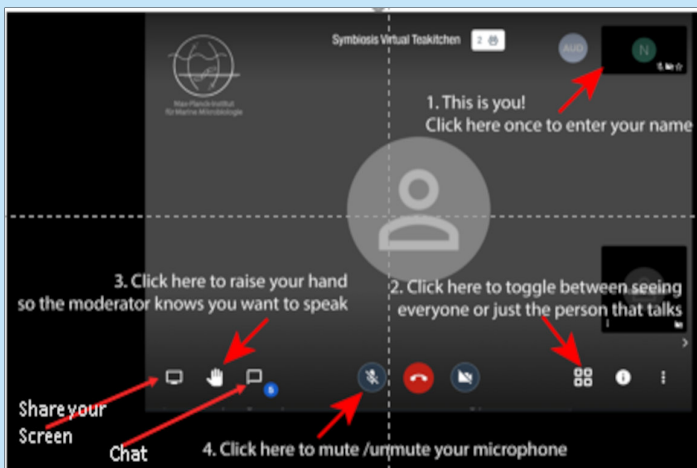
Jitsi is a collection of Open Source projects which provide state-of-the-art video conferencing capabilities that are secure.

- HD audio and video
- unlimited free meeting access for up to 100 participants at a time
- End-to End encryption
- Multiple participants can share their screen simultaneously and remotely control other desktops



Getting started

- The video chats are realized via <https://jitsi.mpi-bremen.de>.
- The video conference has to be started by an user of the MPI, please use the same credentials for that like you use it for your computer / for your email-account (username and password)
- You can invite any person to the video conference, they must not have an user account
- The system can be used with computers as well as mobile devices
- Attending via phone call is possible too
- The conferences are multi-user capable and can of course be protected with a password.



First steps

- you can create a conference on your computer and test it with your mobile phone to enter the conference
- you could do it via <https://jitsi.mpi-bremen.de> or alternatively by appending a room name to the address, for example: <https://jitsi.mpi-bremen.de/videokonferenzen-sind-toll>.
- At <https://chat.mpi-bremen.de> you will find an internal chat system that may be accessed by everyone with their MPI-Bremen account
